Mes Amis Policies

Hours of Operations

We are open from 7:30 A.M – 5:30 P.M, Monday through Friday. If you are going to be late in the evenings, we would appreciate a phone call. Please note that our insurance coverage does not extend beyond 5:30 pm. In addition, if you are late, you will be required to pay the staff who is watching your child after hours \$5.00 for every five minutes past 5:30 P.M. Children MUST be dropped off by 9:30 unless a call is made before then to let us know that your child will be late; if no call is made we will assume your child will not be in that day and their space will be gone. Children will NOT be allowed to be dropped off after 11:30 A.M. and not before 1:30 P.M. as well as after 2:30. (This does not apply to children attending kindergarten.)

Sign In

When your child arrives and departs, please record his or her name and specific times on the sign in/out sheet.

Sickness

If your child is sick due to an illness, they must be able to participate in our daily activities in order to attend Mes Amis. Mes Amis will follow the Standards and Guidelines for Health in Child Care Settings, therefore with sicknesses such as Pink Eye, your child will be required to stay home for 24 hours after medication has been administered.

Medication

Prescription medication will only be administered if it is in the original container and we can read the label. We cannot legally administer <u>any</u> non-prescription medication without a signed doctor's note. Tempra, Children's Tylenol, etc. will not be administered by daycare staff without a doctor's directions and signature. Medication should be given directly to a staff member to be stored for the day. Please remember to fill out a medication sheet, which is usually easily accessible in the classroom or office. In addition, we are <u>peanut</u>, <u>nut</u> and <u>egg</u> free, due to children and staff who have severe allergies.

Lost Items

Clothing and other articles should be labelled with your child's name. We cannot be held responsible for lost articles, although the lost and found items will be readily available for your perusal.

Payments

Payments must be paid in advance bi-monthly. The centre can only be run efficiently if your fees are paid on time, thus we encourage your cooperation. There will be a late fee of \$5/day for outstanding payments.

We encourage that your fees be paid on the 15th and at end of each month in order to keep your child's space. Payments can be made with cash, cheque, or email money transfers. All receipts issued are the original copies and should be kept for income tax purposes; yearly receipts will not be issued.

Storms

We only close if absolutely necessary because we realize that parents have to work and cannot leave. However, in the event that there is a storm, please check your email and call daycare to listen to the voicemail for closure information.

Holidays

Mes Amis Daycare will be CLOSED form Dec.24th – Jan.1st each year and reopen on Jan.2nd; Parents are still expected to pay fees for this week that the centre is closed. As a result of the centre being closed for the Christmas week, staff are not able to accept Christmas gifts as your gift to them is a paid vacation.

Absenteeism

If your child is going to be absent on a scheduled day, please call and let us know. Your child's group may have something special planned for that day. In addition, these days will still have to be paid for.

Snacks & Lunches

Two Week Notice

In the event that your child will no longer be attending Mes Amis Preschool and Daycare, we require a two week notice or a two week fee will be charged.

Professional Development Days

Mes Amis does close 1 day every year for professional development, as staff are required to obtain 10 hours of professional development every year. You are required to still pay for these days as staff are still being paid.

Subsidy Approvals

If you are receiving subsidy and fail to send in the required information to renew your subsidy and we do not hear anything from them, you are responsible for paying the total amount owing to daycare. Resubmits will only be done with in the last two months.

Children need healthy snacks. A snack should include foods from at least two food groups of Canada's Food Guide. There are lots of tasty foods in the four food groups that you can mix and match. Here are some examples:
